Fee Payment Rules and Regulation

1 Mode of Payments-

- a) Fees can be paid through the School Fees app.
- b) Fees can be paid in the bank.
- c) Fees can be paid in the School Office from 10.00 AM to 01.00 PM on Thursday and Friday.

2. Payment Dates- Fees should be paid from 01st to 15th of every month.

3. Payment of fees after the Due Date- In case of late fees (if fees paid after 15th of the month), parents are requested to pay the late fees of Rs. 100/- per month of delay.

4. Term fee for the First Term is to be paid along with the Tuition Fees for June.

5. II Term Fees is to be paid along with Tuition Fees for November. Delay in payment beyond 2 months renders a student's name liable to be struck off the roll, without any notice.

6. One month's notice is to be given before the withdrawal of name of a student; otherwise a month's fees will be charged.

7. No student will be allowed to sit for the Terminal or the Final exam unless all dues have been paid up to date.

8. Fees for the months of April and May must be paid before the commencement of the Annual Examination or 31st March whichever is earlier.

9. There will be no refund of fees under any circumstances.

10. In case of students, of Std. X fees for the Whole year must be paid before 31st August every year.

MEDICAL EXAMINATION

Every pupil will undergo a thorough medical examination by the Doctors appointed by the Managing Committee. Parents are requested to co - operate with the school in the follow - up treatment . Pupils who fail to attend the inspection will have to produce the Cumulative report duly filled in by the family physician. Parents are expected to respond immediately when urgent attention is required.

HELPS TO STUDY

" How to learn more, in less time "

General Hints

1. Take up first the subject you dislike the most : once you have done this, the rest of your work will be easy.
2. Do not hesitate to ask your teacher or your cleverer companions, things you do not grasp clearly. Never leave difficulties unanswered , as this will put you into greater difficulties, later .
3. To make sure that you have understood something thoroughly, use these 'tricks'
 - a) Pretend that you are explaining the lesson to another; see if you can do it well.
 - b) Make yourself your own teacher and question yourself and answer honestly (don't cheat)
- 4 . Do not continue working when you are tired : walk round the garden, or talk to a friend or have some other pleasant interruption, but only long enough to refresh you, to finish your lesson, and not waste time.
5. Get enough exercise everyday, it keeps the mind fresh
6. Do not cut down necessary sleep in order to study : it will hurt you later on .
7. Never omit the lesson or home-work assigned. If you do, it is like missing a train that you can never catch afterwards.



8. If memory work is assigned, learn it overnight and repeat it the first thing in the morning.
9. Always take down in your diary the work that is assigned for the next day.
10. All home work should be done neatly and the day's work should always be dated. Each new home-work should be done on a fresh page.
11. As you grow up, make a daily time-table for yourself for your study, the different subjects in order of difficulty, the most difficult one being first, For your rest and recreation also. In this way you will learn to be a man of regular habits, a most valuable asset in later life.
12. Revise at the end of the week all that was learnt during the week.
13. Lastly, pray often to the All - wise and All - knowing God, to help you make progress in your studies.



ADVICE TO PARENTS OR GUARDIANS

1. Parents or Guardians are earnestly requested to enforce on their wards regularity, discipline and serious application to studies.
2. Parents or Guardians should address their complaints or grievances to the class teacher.
3. Parents should not arrange with any of the school teachers for any tuition without the prior permission of the Principal.
4. Parents or Guardians will not be allowed to speak to or Interview teachers during the school hours.
5. Parents are requested to inform of any change of address or Phone number without delay.
6. Parents are requested to send their children to school in neat and tidy school uniform without which they will be refused admission to the class.
7. Please ask for the Progress Report, sign it regularly and attend to the child's progress.
8. For all the students Aadhar card is Mandatory.
9. Strict regularity and implicit obedience must be followed in the class .
10. Any reported or observed objectionable conduct even out of the institution will be punished .
11. Parents must be given to understand that they cannot dictate to school authorities, but, the school authorities have a right to say on what conditions they will admit or retain students in their institution.
12. Politeness and courtesy of speech and conduct as well as cleanliness of dress and person is mandatory.
13. No child suffering from a contagious or infectious disease shall be permitted to attend the institution.
14. Parents can communicate with teachers by writing on pg. 90

RULES FOR PUPILS

1. Pupils must bring Progress card on the reopening day.
2. Pupils must be in School premises about 10 minutes before the School Session.
3. All pupils must attend the Assembly.
4. **All Pupils are responsible to the School Authority for their behavior in school and even outside the School -premises.**
5. Pupils themselves are responsible for the safe custody of their books and belongings.
6. No extra leave is to be granted in the course of the year except in case of illness when a Medical Certificate will have to be produced.
7. If the pupils for unexplained reasons have been absent from School for more than a month their names are struck off the roll and as a rule they are not readmitted.
8. All pupils who are late or absent must bring a written application or justification in the calendar for the record of Absence / Delay.
9. No pupil will be exempted from Physical Education with out a Doctor's Certificate.
10. Any damage done to school - property in class or inside the school premises will have to be made good by those responsible for it.
11. Pupils who fail to be present on the reopening day after the summer and Diwali vacations are liable to be fined to the extent of Rs.10/- per day.
12. Except text books and note books: no other books, shall be allowed to be brought to School without approva.
13. Pupils should not bring money to school. Use of valuable things like Wrist - Watches, Gold ornaments etc. is strictly prohibited
14. Use of two - strap - slippers is strictly disallowed.
15. Student who is not in full uniform will be denied entry in side the school gate.
16. Students found possessing lethal weapons , explosives & any other harmful things are liable to be expelled forth with.
17. Every pupil must possess a copy of the School Calendar which must be brought to school everyday.
18. Pupils are not allowed to present the teacher with any gift either in school or outside and arrange any function in the school or outside in honour of the teacher.

19. Pupils found attempting to copy during Examination or Unit Test will be expelled.
20. For breach of any of the school rules or discipline a pupil will be taken to task. The discretion of the Principal will be final.
21. Special care must be taken by pupils to preserve Serious Work Atmosphere during class hours. Strict silence must be observed outside the Principal's office.
22. System of Distribution of sweet for birthday celebration is strictly banned in this school. Instead exchange of good wishes can be done.
23. All students must attend the functions, competitions, Exams etc. in the school uniform held either in the school or arranged outside
24. Each pupil must have 75 % of the attendance to get promotion to the next higher class.
25. Students coming to school should always be in school uniform.
26. Pupils should maintain silence and must walk in single line while going from one class to another or while going for PT They should always keep to the left. Running, playing or shouting inside the school premises during the recess is not permitted. All should try to maintain the atmosphere of serious work and silence in the school. Students returning from computer lab, science lab, playground and hobby classes should go to their respective classrooms quietly. Students are not allowed to loiter in the corridor when classed are in session.
27. Eating tiffin on the stairs and in the corridors is not allowed.
28. Care should be taken to keep the classroom and School premises clean.
29. This is an English Medium School. All are expected to speak in English within the school premises.

Please Note :

All pupils when admitted and while studying in the School are governed by and must make themselves acquainted with the rules of the school for their conduct, discipline and application .

Ignorance of School Rules is no excuse .

EXAMINATION

- 1) 2 Unit tests and 2 Semester - examinations will be conducted during the year . Promotion of every student to the next standard will be decided by the committee of principal, supervisor and class teacher on the basis of average marks obtained by him in the above said 4 examinations as well as oral examination, written works etc.
- 2) Model rules of promotion as prescribed by Government will be applied to all the students equally and impartially.
- 3) Attendance for all the examinations is compulsory and absence without genuine reason will not be condone for the purpose of promotion. Absence from a complete subject excludes a pupil from being reckoned in the order of merit or rank in examination .
- 4) Any Pupil suffering from any kind of disease will not be permitted to enter the classroom till certified as fit by the Doctor.
- 5) Parents are requested to sign in full, in all Examination reports and notices from the School and submit the report cards to the authorities within four days from their receipt. All pupils must return Progress Cards when they return to School after Holidays . Loss of the Report card may involve a fine of Rs. 50 / - New copy of progress card will have to be purchased by paying Rs. 50/-
- 6) No re - examinations shall be arranged for those pupils who fail.
- 7) Except for the mistakes in totalling of marks annual result of any student once declared shall not be changed under any circumstances, Parents of detained students are advised not to meet principal for the same.
- 8) Student failing successively twice in the same standard will have to leave the school.
- 9) Decision regarding allotment of divisions to students will be exclusively taken by school authorities as per requirements and conveniences of the school.
- 10) Parents are requested to note that in reality, it is the duty of the parents to make sure that their wards attend the

classes punctually and regularly, study regularly, behave properly and obediently. If they feel dissatisfied, they are requested to see the Principal in this connection. If after all the formalities they feel " Not Satisfied " they may withdraw their wards from the School in their own interest instead of blaming the School and the teachers continuously.



COURTESY

- 1) Parents and pupils shall always greet their teachers, elders and friends in a pleasant voice whenever they meet in School or outside.
- 2) Pupils shall maintain a good posture wherever they sit, stand or walk.
- 3) Always try to be cheerful and good tempered.
- 4) Be polite in speaking with one another. Take care never to interrupt anyone while talking.
- 5) Parents and pupils shall obey and respect the teachers by showing and giving affection that is their due. Accept guidance corrections with gratitude.



DUTIES OF A MONITOR

A monitor must be very obedient to teachers and superiors. He should be very regular and systematic in his work and duties. He is responsible for home - work and discipline of all pupils in his class. He should also be a keen Sportsman.

- 1) He has to look after discipline, uniform, class work and home work.
- 2) He has to report to the class - teacher about the absentees, late coming and those who are irregular in class.
- 3) He has to mind the class in the teacher's absence arrange for self - study of the subject and maintain silence and order.
- 4) He has to attend periodical meetings of all monitors.
- 5) Monitor will neither leave the class nor allow any one to leave the class without teacher's permission.
- 6) He will take care of class - room furniture ; fixtures and the teaching aids put up in the class. A monitor is a willing worker, and as such he or she deserves respect and honour. He is also a link between students and school authorities.



CLASSROOM CONDUCT FOR STUDENTS

Every student is expected to :

Be punctual :

- ◆ Arrive in class on time so that you are ready to start the lesson. Being late to class is not allowed because it disrupts the efforts of both your teacher and your fellow pupils.
- ◆ Take out what you need for your lesson as soon as you get to your desk or table. Do not wait to be told to do so. This shows that you are mature, responsible and self motivated.

Be prepared :

- ◆ Bring what is needed for the lesson , the books, stationery and writing implements you need, your homework done and, most importantly, be ready to learn and contribute to the lesson.

Be respectful :

- ◆ Stand when an adult enters the room . You do this to show respect for the adult concerned. Wait for either your teacher or the adult concerned to ask you to sit.
- ◆ Greet your teacher at the start and end of each lesson.
- ◆ Respect your teacher and your peers by not talking when your teacher is talking. If you want to contribute, raise your hand and wait for your teacher to allow you to speak.
- ◆ Listen to your peers during classroom discussion, and wait for your turn to respond.
- ◆ Do not pack away your books until the teacher has indicated that the lesson is over. This disrupts the lesson and is inconsiderate to your peers and your teacher.
- ◆ Respect the property of others and of the school . Do not deface desks, steal drawing pins, mess with chalk, fiddle with the overhead projector or borrow things without permission .
- ◆ Keep your classroom neat and clean. Put litter and paper scraps in the dust bin , not in the desk or on the floor. No one likes to work in a dirty and untidy environment.

Be responsible :

- ◆ Take responsibility firstly for yourself and for your own behavior . Encourage your peers to do the same.

Be supportive :

- ◆ Do what you can to make everyone feel happy and accepted in your class. Always be willing to widen your circle of friends to ensure that no one is left out.
- ◆ With the permission of your teacher , help those who may be struggling.

Right to amend, modify or add to existing rules is reserved by School. School rules, at all times shall be binding on students and their parents.
